Suzan Wynne will present a program entitled, *The Galitzianers: The Jews of Galicia*, on March 4, 2018. Following a brief historical and geographical overview of this former province of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, now situated in Poland and

Ukraine, Suzan will address questions from those in attendance about research issues.

Bio: Suzan Wynne

Suzan Wynne has been involved with the Jewish genealogy movement since 1977 as a teacher, lecturer, author and former professional. A founding member of the Jewish Genealogy Society of Greater Washington, in 1993 she founded Geshet Galicia, a Special Interest Group (SIG) for Jews with roots in Galicia, part of the old Austro-Hungarian Empire. She has written two books about Jewish genealogical research for Galitzianers, and has contributed to or written numerous articles for *Avotaynu*, the journal of Jewish genealogy, and chapters of several books about genealogy. Suzan is a retired clinical social worker.
